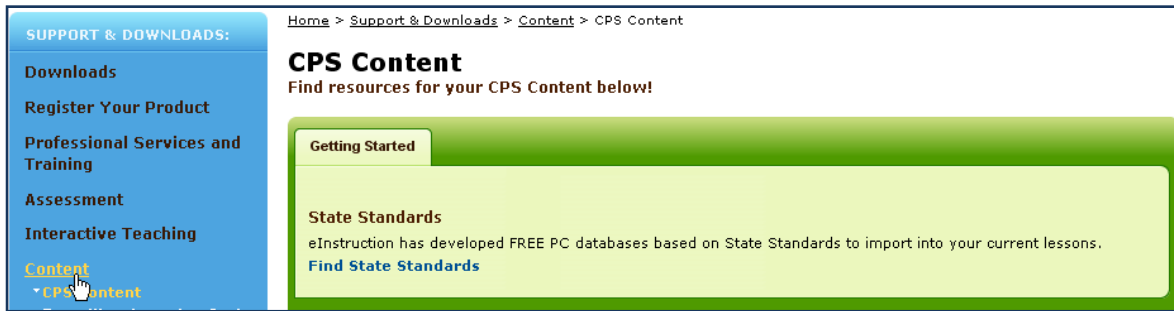

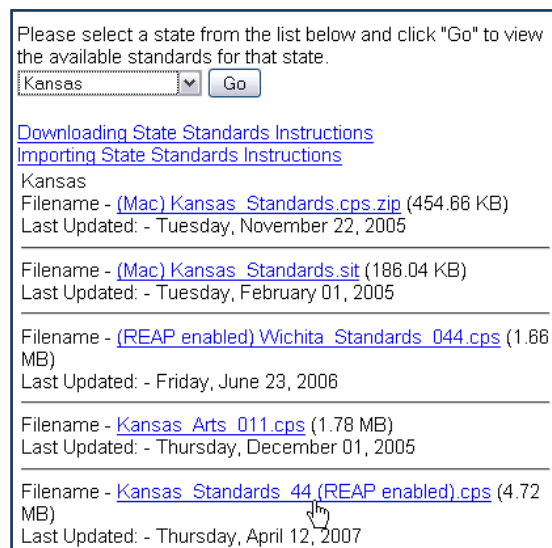

Standards – On the Downloads screen, click “Content” and “Find State Standards.”
