  - Content and Literacy Objectives

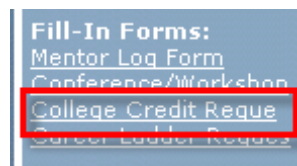

- Take advantage of the CPS software by creating a project where students will be actively engaged in the lesson. Create quizzes that engage your students and allow them immediate feedback.
- Your project should include a minimum of 3 quizzes:
  - Traditional Lesson
  - Fast Grade
  - CPS for PowerPoint
- Project should be free of spelling, punctuation and grammar errors.
- Project should be clearly connected to standards.

Lessons that meet these requirements will be posted on the USD 259 website for others to use.
